The successor to the PlayStation 2, it is part of the PlayStation brand of consoles. 4, £ It was first released on November 11, 2006, in Japan, November 17, 2006, in North America, and March 23, 2007, 4, £ in Europe and Australia.[15] The PlayStation 3 competed primarily aga inst Microsoft's Xbox 360 and Nintendo's Wii as part of the 4, £ seventh generation of video game consoles.</p>

<p>The console was first officially announced at E3 2005, and was released at the end 4 , £ of 2006. It was the first console to use Blu-ray Disc technolog y as its primary storage medium.[16] The console was 4 , £ the first PlayStation to integrate social gaming services, including the PlayStation Network, as well as the first to be controllable 4 , £ from a handheld console, through its remote connectivity with PlayStation Portable and PlayStation Vita.[17][18][19] In Sep tember 2009, the Slim model 4 , £ of the PlayStation 3 was released. It no longer provided the hardware ability to run PS2 games. It was lighter 4 , £ and thinner than the original version, and featured a redesigned logo and marketing design, as well as a minor start-up 4 , £ change in software. A Super Slim variation was then released in late 2012, further refining and redesigning the console.</p &qt;

<p>During its 4 , £ early years, the system received a mixed reception, due to its high price (\$599 for a 60-gigabyte model,R\$499 for a 4 , £ 20 GB model), a complex processor architecture, and lack of quality games but was praised for its Blu-ray capabilities and 4 , £ "untapped potential". The reception would get more positive over time. The system had a slow start in the market[20] but 4 , £ managed to recover, particularly after the introduction of the Slim model, and managed to sell 87.4 million units to outsell 4 , £ the competing Xbox 3 60 and become the eighth-bestselling video game console in history. Its successo r, the PlayStation 4, was released 4 , £ later in November 2013. On September 29, 2024, Sony confirmed that sales of the PlayStation 3 were to be discontinued 4 , £ in New Zealand, but the system remained in production in other markets.[21] S hipments of new units to Europe and Australia 4 , £ ended in March 2024, followed by North America which ended in October 2024.[22][23] Heading into 2024, Japan was the last 4 , £ territory where new units were still being produced until May 29, 2024, when Sony confirmed the PlayStation 3 was discontinued 4 , £ in Japan.[
