He played for Arg entinos Juniors, Boca Juniors, Barcelona, Napoli, Sevilla, and O, £ Newell's Old Boys during his club career, and is most famous for his time at Napoli wher e he won numerous O, £ accolades and led the club to Serie A title wins twice. M aradona also had a troubled off-field life and his O, £ time with Napoli ended a fter he was banned for taking cocaine.</p&gt;

&It;p>In his international career with Argentina, he earned 91 caps 0, £ and scored 34 goals. Maradona played in four FIFA World Cups, including the 1986 Wor Id Cup in Mexico, where he 0, £ captained Argentina and led them to victory over West Germany in the final, and won the Golden Ball as the 0, £ tournament's best player. In the 1986 World Cup quarter final, he scored both goals in a 2 1 victory over England 0, £ that entered football history for two different reaso ns.
