<p>An O , £ advanced playmaker who operated in the classic number 10 positi on, Maradona's vision, passing, ball control, and dribbling skills were comb ined O , £ with his small stature, which gave him a low centre of gravity and all owed him to manoeuvre better than most O , £ other players. His presence and lead ership on the field had a great effect on his team's general performance, wh ile he O , £ would often be singled out by the opposition. In addition to his cre ative abilities, he possessed an eye for goal O , £ and was known to be a free ki ck specialist. A precocious talent, Maradona was given the nickname El Pibe de O , £ Oro ("The Golden Boy"), a name that stuck with him throughout his career.</p>

<p>Maradona was the first player to set the O , £ world record transfer fee twice: in 1982 when he transferred to Barcelona for £5 million, and in 198 4 when he O , £ moved to Napoli for a fee of £6.9 million. He played for Arg entinos Juniors, Boca Juniors, Barcelona, Napoli, Sevilla, and O , £ Newell's Old Boys during his club career, and is most famous for his time at Napoli wher e he won numerous O , £ accolades and led the club to Serie A title wins twice. M aradona also had a troubled off-field life and his O , £ time with Napoli ended a fter he was banned for taking cocaine.</p>

<p>In his international career with Argentina, he earned 91 caps O , £ and scored 34 goals. Maradona played in four FIFA World Cups, including the 1986 Wor ld Cup in Mexico, where he O , £ captained Argentina and led them to victory over West Germany in the final, and won the Golden Ball as the O , £ tournament's best player. In the 1986 World Cup quarter final, he scored both goals in a 2 1 victory over England O , £ that entered football history for two different reaso ns. The first goal was an unpenalized handling foul known as the "Hand O , £ of God"; while the second goal followed a 60 m (66 yd) dribble past five E ngland players, voted "Goal of O , £ the Century" by FIFA voters in 200 2.</p>
